I am writing to you regarding the installation of waterless urinals in the senior and junior boys' toilets at Currambine Catholic Primary School.

The product recommended to us by you has been an outstanding success, particularly in a school setting. We found the polycarbonate units are a real advantage in a school environment regarding vandalism and the design of the urinals with the large back wall is an advantage when it comes to hygiene. Parents are able to use these units as well. Quite apart from the obvious environmental and water conservation benefits, there has been a marked improvement in the general health and hygiene in the toilet areas.
